

ACEs Mobile Response Program

The ACES team is a 24/7 mobile crisis response team, which responds rapidly to the home, providing crisis intervention and care coordination to children (up to age 18) who have been directly affected by an opioid misuse event in Nashua or Hudson. A clinician from GNMH, in conjunction with a recovery support specialist from Revive Recovery center will assist with the assessment of the immediate child and family's needs. The follow-up services may be provided at the clinic, in community settings such as schools, and at the homes of clients and their families.

- Individual, group and family therapy including a Dialectical Behavior Therapy (DBT) program for adolescents
- 7 Challenges Substance use disorder evaluation and treatment for clients 12 years and older, including group therapy
- Project RENEW, empowering youth to create future opportunities
- Functional Support Services, designed to help clients develop resiliency and to function at their highest level in their own communities
- InteGreat Health program, providing clients with primary and behavioral health care in one convenient location, resulting in whole person health. Now serving clients ages 16 and older

Referrals Provided by Revive Recovery:

- Parenting Journey in Recovery (PJIR) - a 14-week program
- Groups that can support every aspect of an individual's recovery (Parenting, Family, Women/Men in Recovery)
- Individualized one-on-one Recovery Coaching
